WELCOME DAY!


We take welcomings very seriously

Get a general overview and analyze each section of Spanish history with a selection of films and historical texts






FRIDAYS - CULTURAL ACTIVITIES




Visit to City of Arts & Sciences

VISA INFORMATION


During your online application, you will be asked if you require a Visa support letter, which we will send you once your fees have been paid.
