### Observations

**Asistencia y participación activa** a las sesiones de clase, a los trabajos en grupo, a las tutorías y a los seminarios. Su evaluación se realizará mediante registros de seguimiento de la asistencia por parte del profesor **y por la valoración de la participación activa del alumno mediante intervenciones y debates en el aula y la participación en foros y chats de la asignatura.** La mera asistencia pasiva del alumno no se tendrá en cuenta para el cómputo de este porcentaje. La falta de asistencia no justificada al 20% de las sesiones prácticas impide el cómputo de este porcentaje.

**Evaluación práctica:** Resolución de las diferentes prácticas que se le propondrán al alumno a lo largo del curso. La evaluación de las prácticas y el trabajo en grupo se llevará a cabo mediante la asistencia y presentación oral y/o escrita de las diferentes prácticas y trabajos propuestos (ya sea presencialmente o el aula virtual). Se evaluará el trabajo desarrollado en grupo y/o individualmente por el alumno. La evaluación de los trabajos presentados se realizará teniendo en cuenta la estructura del trabajo, la calidad de la documentación, la ortografía y la presentación y principalmente, la argumentación y fundamentación jurídico-legales. La calificación se obtendrá de la media de todas las calificaciones obtenidas en este apartado.

**Las calificaciones inferiores a 5 no computan en el porcentaje.** La calificación de las prácticas realizadas en clase o fuera de la clase (con nota igual o superior a 5), se mantendrán para la segunda convocatoria. **La falta de asistencia no justificada al 20% de las sesiones prácticas impide el cómputo de este porcentaje.**

**Evaluación teórica:** Pruebas escritas teórico-prácticas (tipo test con respuesta múltiple y/o tipo respuesta corta y/o verdadero/falso, etc.) en las que se expondrán los conocimientos teóricos y prácticos adquiridos y el conocimiento de la legislación vigente. **Es imprescindible obtener un mínimo de 5 sobre 10 en el examen para poder hacer la media con la nota de prácticas.**

**Las calificaciones inferiores a 5 no computan en el porcentaje. Si se obtiene una nota inferior a 5 en el examen oficial de la primera convocatoria, la nota media final de las**



**prácticas realizadas en clase y/o trabajos en grupo (con nota igual o superior a 5), se mantendrán para la segunda convocatoria.**

Por último, dada la importancia de la correcta presentación formal de escritos jurídicos, se advierte que **cada falta ortográfica descontará 0'1 puntos de la nota del examen.**

## Learning activities

The following methodologies will be used so that the students can achieve the learning outcomes of the subject:

- M1 Group work sessions supervised by the teacher. Study of legal cases, both true and fictitious. Significant construction of knowledge through student interaction and activity. Critical analysis of values and social commitment.
- M8 Exposition of contents by the teacher, analysis of competences, explanation and demonstration of capacities, skills and knowledge in the classroom.
- M9 Supervised monographic sessions with shared participation.
- M11 Personalised attention and in small groups. Period of instruction and/or orientation carried out by a tutor with the aim of reviewing and discussing the materials and topics presented in the classes, seminars, readings, completion of assignments, etc.
- M12 Set of written and/or oral tests used in the initial, formative or summative evaluation of the student.



- M13 Group preparation of readings, essays, resolution of problems, seminars, papers, dossiers, etc., to be presented or delivered in theory classes, practical classes, and/or small group tutorials.
