Observations

Attendance and active participation in class sessions, group work, tutorials and seminars. Its evaluation will be carried out through attendance monitoring records by the teacher and by assessing the active participation of the student through interventions and debates in the classroom and participation in forums and chats of the subject. The mere passive attendance of the student will not be taken into account for the calculation of this percentage. Unjustified lack of attendance at 20% of the practical sessions prevents the calculation of this percentage. Practical evaluation: Resolution of the different practices that will be proposed to the student throughout the course.

The evaluation of the practices and group work will be carried out through attendance and oral and/or written presentation of the different practices and proposed works (either in person or in the virtual classroom). The work developed in groups and/or individually by the student will be evaluated. The evaluation of the presented works will be carried out taking into account the structure of the work, the quality of the documentation, spelling and presentation and mainly, the legal-legal argumentation and foundation. The grade will be obtained from the average of all the grades obtained in this section.

Grades less than 5 do not count in the percentage. The qualification of the practices carried out in class or outside of class (with a grade equal to or greater than 5), will be maintained for the second call. Unjustified lack of attendance at 20% of the practical sessions prevents the calculation of this percentage.

Theoretical evaluation: Written theoretical-practical tests (test type with multiple response and/or short answer type and/or true/false, etc.) in which the theoretical and practical knowledge acquired and the knowledge of current legislation will be presented. It is essential to obtain a minimum of 5 out of 10 in the exam to be able to average the practice grade. Grades less than 5 do not count in the percentage. If a grade lower than 5 is obtained in the official exam of the first call, the final average grade of the practices carried out in class and/or group work (with a grade equal to or greater than 5) will be maintained for the second call. Finally, given the importance of the correct



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formal presentation of legal writings, it is noted that each spelling mistake will deduct 0.1 points from the exam grade. Failure to comply with the rules and deadlines established for the completion and delivery of the requested academic activities will lead to a negative evaluation of the activity. Extraordinary call: The evaluation system and its percentages of practice grades and attendance and participation are maintained in the extraordinary call.

Class attendance by nursing mothers: Due to the schedule of this subject, nursing mothers may be absent from class, after notifying the teacher only once. The teacher will establish, together with the student who is in this circumstance, an alternative work plan to allow her to acquire the same knowledge and skills as the rest of her classmates.

SINGLE EVALUATION: In accordance with article 9 of the General Regulations for the Evaluation and Qualification of Official Teachings and Qualifications of the UCV, the continuous evaluation system is the preferred evaluation system at the UCV. The art. 10 allows, however, for those students who in a justified and accredited manner express their inability to attend in person (or to synchronous communication activities for virtual and/or hybrid teaching modalities), their evaluation on an extraordinary basis in the so-called single evaluation. Said single evaluation must be requested within the first month of each semester to the Dean of Faculty through the Vice-Deaneries or Master's Directorates, with the express decision on the admission of said request from the student concerned being the responsibility of the latter. The minimum required attendance percentage is 70%, which is the limit to be considered for the potential request for a unique evaluation.

The evidence to be presented and/or the test/s to be carried out in the single evaluation by the student will be carried out through the same theoretical test as for the rest of the students and through a practical test consisting of a written test, although the percentages awarded to the different evaluation instruments will be the following: 50% practical test and 50% theoretical test. Use of AI: In this subject, the use of any type of AI for the completion of exercises, assignments, and evaluation tests is not permitted.



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CLASS ATTENDANCE IN FACE-TO-FACE DEGREES

In accordance with the development guidelines of the General Regulations for the Evaluation and Qualification of Official Teachings and Own Degrees of the UCV, in face-to-face degrees, class attendance with a minimum of 80% of the sessions of each subject will be required as a requirement. to be evaluated. This means that, if a student does not attend the sessions of each subject, in a percentage greater than 20%, he/she will not be able to be evaluated, neither in the first nor in the second call, unless the person responsible for the subject, with the approval of the person responsible for degree, in view of duly justified exceptional circumstances, exempt from the minimum attendance percentage. The same criterion will be applicable for hybrid or virtual degrees in which teachers must maintain the same percentage in the requirement of "presence" in the different training activities, if any, even if these are carried out in virtual environments.

MENTION OF DISTINCTION:

The mention of "Honors" may be awarded to students who have obtained a grade equal to or greater than 9.0. Their number may not exceed five percent of the students enrolled in a group in the corresponding academic year, unless the number of students enrolled is lower.

Learning activities

The following methodologies will be used so that the students can achieve the learning outcomes of the subject:

- M1 Group work sessions supervised by the teacher. Study of legal cases, both true and fictitious. Significant construction of knowledge through student interaction and activity. Critical analysis of values and social commitment.
- M8 Exposition of contents by the teacher, analysis of competences, explanation and demonstration of capacities, skills and knowledge in the classroom.
- M9 Supervised monographic sessions with shared participation.
- M11 Personalised attention and in small groups. Period of instruction and/or orientation carried out by a tutor with the aim of reviewing and discussing the materials and topics presented in the classes, seminars, readings, completion of assignments, etc.
- M12 Set of written and/or oral tests used in the initial, formative or summative evaluation of the student.
- M13 Group preparation of readings, essays, resolution of problems, seminars, papers, dossiers, etc., to be presented or delivered in theory classes, practical classes, and/or small group tutorials.



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M14 Student's study: individual preparation of readings, essays, problem-solving, seminars, works, reports, etc. to present or deliver in the theoretical classes, practical classes and/or small group tutorials.
