Recommended knowledge

In general, it will be a prerequisite to have passed the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year of the Degree of Human Nutrition and Dietetics or the subjects of the Degree of Human Nutrition and Dietetics of 1st, 2nd and 3rd year in the case of the double degree, that is, a total of 180 ECTS. Exceptionally, it may be permitted, subject to supervision by the Vice-Department and management of the department:

•the module of internships in Hospital, External Clinics and UCV Clinics if it is pending approval of 1 or 2 subjects not related to the clinic, that is, Community Nutrition and Collective Restoration, Public Health and Food Education, Epidemiology, Legislation and Management Systems of Quality and Hygiene and Food Safety 3rd year.

•The module of internship in Business or Collective Catering if it is pending to approve 1 or maximum 2 subjects not related: Parenteral and hospital nutrition, nutritional pathology.

Observations

MENTION OF DISTINCTION:

In accordance with the regulations governing the assessment and grading of subjects in force at UCV, the distinction of "Matrícula de Honor" (Honours with Distinction) may be awarded to students who have achieved a grade of 9.0 or higher. The number of "Matrículas de Honor" (Honours with Distinction) may not exceed five percent of the students enrolled in the group for the corresponding academic year, unless the number of enrolled students is fewer than 20, in which case a single "Matrícula de Honor" (Honours with Distinction) may be awarded. Exceptionally, these distinctions may be assigned globally across different groups of the same subject. Nevertheless, the total number of distinctions awarded will be the same as if they were assigned by group, but they may be distributed among all students based on a common criterion, regardless of the group to which they belong. The criteria for awarding "Matrícula de Honor" (Honours with Distinction) will be determined according to the guidelines stipulated by the professor responsible for the course, as detailed in the "Observations" section of the evaluation system in the course guide.

- M5 Student study: individual preparation of readings, essays, problem solving, seminars, papers, reports, etc. for discussion or delivery in electronic format.
